The Wisconsin Chapter of the International Interior Designers Association (IIDA) held the **2009 Interior Perspectives**, in conjunction with the AIA Wisconsin (American Institute of Architects) Convention and Building Products Expo on May 20 & 21, 2009 at the Monona Terrace, One John Nolen Drive, Madison.

Interior Perspectives included a variety of informational speakers and CEU learning units. Speakers included Rusty McBride, LC, Regional Vice President for Lightolier spoke about "Understand LED Technology & How It Works". McBride has been involved with several industry think tanks, has been published in LDA and is actively involved in several high profile projects. This seminar was provided to AIA members at no charge and was well attended. Theodore Drab presented "Language & Design". Drab reinforced a stronger profession by helping designers build a vocabulary that reinforces professionalism and articulate the role of interior designers as a profession. Christine Astorino-Delsole, the founder of Fathom, engaged us in "Fathom the Possibilities of Deeper Design". Participants learned how to delve into client's subconscious thoughts and desire in order to create the ideal space. And Lastly, Bryan Walker, a research lead member in the Human Factors Group and Smart Space, spoke on "Breathing Life into Buildings: How IDEO Uses its "Design Thinking" Approach to Innovate Physical Spaces". He encouraged Designers to address a means of problem solving that uses design methodologies to tap into a deep reservoir of opportunity.

Interior Perspectives was well attended again this year by our membership. Thank you to all those who attended. Thank you for taking your profession seriously by expanding your knowledge and for supporting IIDA- WI.

We wrapped up the evening with our member benefit CEU from Dr. Mike O'Neil, "Future Work and The Workplace."

Summer in the (Windy) City

Chapter Leadership Council, CLC, is a bi-annual two day event hosted and presented by IIDA headquarters staff and IIDA international board members. The most recent event was held in June in conjunction with NeoCon at IIDA's headquarters in Chicago, IL. This event provides your chapter's leaders opportunity to learn, communicate, network and get excited about the Association and being a leader.

All areas of discipline of IIDA presented their latest developments. Cheryl Durst, Hon. FIIDA, LEED AP and Executive Vice President and CEO of IIDA began the first day with the State of the Association and told us how IIDA is in great shape and is weathering the economic insecurities well. She went on and spoke about the life cycle of members, the diversity (or lack there of) and how this is a concern. For our profession, the economic situation is going to get worse before it gets better. Cheryl shared what we as chapters can do right now to make a difference and what we can do in preparation for the upturn.

Based on the statistic that 85% of our membership prefers to be reached electronically, HQ is targeting this means of communication. Did you know that the IIDA has a new website presence? Check it out at www.iida.org. In addition to previewing the new website look, branding and future expansion of the website were presented.

The 2009 Designing for the Future Campaign will run from October 1st through November 31st, 2009. DFF is an every Member campaign and IIDA encourages everyone to contribute. This money will be given back to the Members as NCIDQ scholarships, and to support the further development of the NCIDQ Study Program to further assist the Professional Development of Designers across the country. More information on the campaign can be found online under the Foundation section.

The Mohawk Group has recently introduced a series of events called RE:Work. These events are to support designers, architects

who've lost their jobs or are looking for work. The RE:Work sessions include resume workshops, portfolio reviews, and special speaker presentations; including a talk from Executive VP and CEO of IIDA, Cheryl Durst, Hon. FIIDA, LEED AP. The Mohawk group has a strong emphasis on Industry social responsibility. In addition to their strong focus on sustainability, they support Easter Seals and breast cancer research. IIDA has teamed up with Mohawk to support this rebuilding effort and offer options to those members out of work.
